

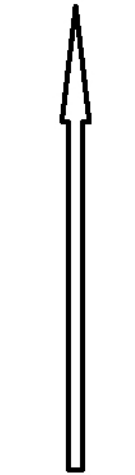

<u>Energy</u>	<u>My Working Term</u>	<u>More Descriptive term</u>	<u>Precise description</u>
Most Harmful	Meandering Noxious Line (MNL)	Meandering 7-Plane Pathway	7 curving, parallel, equidistant vertical planes, around 2 feet wide, infrequent
	Volcanic Line (VL)	Volcanic Single Plane	Single, vertical, sinuously curving plane, 3550 feet long from volcano center to ending spiral
	Straight Noxious Pathway (SNP)	Wide Hundred-Plane Pathway	100's of straight, parallel, equidistant vertical planes, roughly 6 inches apart, over 100 feet wide
	Straight Subtle Line (SSL)	Straight Geopathic 7-Plane Pathway	7 very straight, parallel, equidistant vertical planes, about 6 inches apart, 3 feet wide in total
	Noxious Ray Site (NR)	Single Geopathic Cylinder	Nearly vertical cylinder, diameter varies, originates from a side line of "SNP", above
	Noxious Ray Spiral Line (NRS)	Geopathic 23-Plane Spiral	23-plane spiral, roughly 2 feet wide, connects "SNP" to "NR" (both above), can flow CW or CCW
	Straight Wide Etheric Line (SWE)	Straight 17-Plane Pathway	17 parallel, equidistant, vertical planes at roughly 4 inch spacing, very straight, around 6 feet wide
	Cavity Vortex (CV)	Sinkhole Site	Single Tapered cylinder, CW rotation, downward flow; found with vertical, radial "DE" lines (below)
	Four-Petal Cylinder (4PC)	4-Lobed Vertical Cylinder	4 to 6 foot wide "flower like" pattern with central vertical cylinder and 4 double-spirals on outside
	Negative Bull's-Eye Pattern (NBP)	Geopathic Target Pattern	4 sets of concentric, 5-plane, vertical cylinders with spaces between forming a 10-35 foot "target" pattern
	Narrow Causal Line (NCL)	Bi-directional 5-Plane Pathway	5 vert., parallel, straight, 1 inch wide, equidistant planes; 10 inch total width with bi-directional energy flow
	Triple Vortex Spiral (TVS)	Single Geopathic Spiral	Single, vertical spiraling plane moving CCW from Triple Vortex ("TV") site, (below)
	Wet Etheric Line (WE)	Complex Water Pathway	Day: 23 planes; Night: 3 sets of 3 planes; 2' wide; double-spirals & vert. cylinders; energy-H2O cross-flow
	Shape-Shifting Subtle Line (SSSL)	Straight 16/13-Plane Pathway	16 (day) or 13 (night) vertical, straight, parallel, equidistant planes; about 26 inches wide
	Wide Astral Line (WdAL)	Straight Unequal 11-Plane Pathway	11 parallel, unequally spaced, vertical planes totaling 9 feet in width; uniformly directional and straight
	Negative 4-Spiral Bull's-Eye (N4B)	Four-Spiral Target Pattern	Five concentric vertical cylinders with four CW and CCW vertical spiral planes flowing toward it
	Dry Etheric Line (DE)	Sinkhole 9-Plane Pathway	Resembles "WE" (above) at night; moving radially 1/4 mile from a tight spiral toward a "CV" (above)
	Triple Vortex (TV)	3-Vortex 3-Cylinder Complex	Mixture of 3 CCW vortices connected by vertical spirals to 3 four-plane, beneficial vertical cylinders
	Primary Curry Line (PC)	Primary Curry Grid Plane	3 or 5 (3 planes have energy, 2 do not) parallel, vert. or horiz., equidistant planes, about 6 inches apart
	Secondary Curry Line (SC)	Secondary Curry Grid Line	3 parallel, vert. or horiz., equidistant planes, about 6 inches apart; variable spacing depending on latitude
	Straight Narrow Etheric Line (SNE)	Straight 10-Plane Pathway	Ten Straight, parallel, vertical, equidistant planes; unidirectional and roughly 4 feet wide in total
	Broad Single Line (BSL)	Broad Undulating Single Plane	Six inch wide, single, vertical plane; travels straight, then curves back to reverse direction occasionally
	Stray Voltage Pathway (SV)	Neutral Current Return Pathway	Single vertical plane above line-frequency current passing through the ground; usually straight
	Astral Line (AL)	Weak Straight 7-Plane Pathway	Seven parallel, straight, unidirectional planes, about 8 inches in total width
	Eight-Petal Cylinder (8PC)	Eight-Lobe Spiral Complex	20 foot diameter "flower-like" pattern with a central cylinder surrounded by eight double-spirals
	Spiral Cylinder Complex (SCC)	Complex Spiral Cylinder Pattern	Four 3-foot, vert. cylinders with CW & CCW spirals surrounding 4 concentric, vert. cylinders of 8-foot diam.
	Reversing Etheric Vortex (REV)	Large Day-Night Reversing Vortex	91-foot diam. vortex; day: energy moves down and CW, both reversed at night; energy highest at center
	Negative Mental Line (NML)	Meandering 5-Plane Pathway	Five parallel, vertical, equidistant planes; about 1 foot wide and undulating
	Thin Causal Line (TCL)	Single Day-Night Reversing Plane	Single, very straight, vertical plane; about 1/16 inch wide; reverses energy direction day to night
	Wide Meandering Etheric Line (WME)	Wide Meandering 23-Plane Pathway	23 parallel, vertical, equidistant planes; 12 feet wide and undulating when viewed over a large area
	Crust Fracture Line (CFL)	Crust Fracture Planes	Eleven parallel, vertical, equidistant planes; 25 inch total width; directional when man-made via "fracking"
	Aquastraight Line (AST) at night	Wide 23-Plane Spring Locator	23 straight, parallel, vert., equidistant planes; 20 feet wide; flow between "Aquistats"; outer planes worst
	Primary Hartmann Line (PH)	Primary Hartmann Grid Plane	40 straight, parallel, vertical or horizontal, equidistant planes; about 23 inches wide in total
	Secondary Hartmann Line (SH)	Secondary Hartmann Grid Plane	Either 3 parallel, vert. or horiz. planes, 3 inches apart or 5 parallel, vert. or horiz. planes, 2 inches apart
	Feline Etheric Line (FE)	5-Plane Cat-Affecting Pathway	Five straight, parallel, vertical, equidistant planes; 24 inches wide; only affects cats
	Weak Etheric Line (WEL)	Wide Straight 21-Plane Pathway	Twenty-one straight, parallel, vertical, equidistant planes; 13 feet in total width
	Reversing Monadic Spiral (RMS)	6-Plane Day-Night Reversing Spiral	Night: 6 parallel, vert., equidistant planes in a 10 inch wide spiral flowing inward and CW; day-reversing
	Weak Astral Line (WAL)	Straight Four-Plane Pathway	Four straight, parallel, vertical, equidistant planes; 20 inches wide
	Narrow Magnetic Anomaly (NMA)	5-Plane Non-Uniform Pathway	Two sets of 2 parallel, vertical alternating-direction planes surrounding one vertical unidirectional plane
	Wide Magnetic Anomaly (WMA)	3-Plane Mixed-Direction Pathway	Three parallel, vert., equidistant planes of 7 foot width; outer planes alternate direction; center does not
	Neg. Straight Monadic Path (NSMP)	Wide 70-Plane Pathway	70 straight, parallel, vertical, equidistant, unidirectional planes; about 110 feet wide in total
	Narrow Periodic Subtle Line (NPS)	Periodic 5-Plane Pathway	5 straight, parallel, vertical, equidistant unidirectional planes; 31 inches wide; occurs at 1700-foot intervals
	Wide Occasional Subtle Line (WOS)	20-Plane Day-Night Reversing Path	20 straight, parallel, vertical, equidistant planes; 46 feet wide; energy reverses at night
Least Harmful	Big Multi-Plane Cylinder (BMC)	Enormous 34-Plane Cylinder	34 vert., parallel, equidistant planes at 11-inch intervals forming the outer rim of a 280-foot diam. cylinder
	Big Weak Etheric Cylinder (BWEC)	Large 8-Plane Cylinder	vert., parallel, equidistant planes at 1/2-inch intervals forming the outer rim of a 148 foot diam. cylinder
